English

- Read a variety of fiction non-fiction books as a class and in guided reading.
- Investigate stories from the same author.
- Become more confident when spelling unknown words.
- Explore different types of writing such as instructions, recounts as well as fantasy stories.
- Use terminology such as verb, adjective etc.
- Experiment with a wider range of punctuation

Art & Design

- Local artists
- Exploring natural art - making shapes and patterns.
- Spring Art linked to Kadinsky's circles.
- Using different materials to create an image.

Computing

- Develop already learnt computer skills
- Understand internet safety and how to research carefully
- Solve simple algorithms

Mathematics

- Build on understanding of multiplication and division facts
- Develop addition and subtraction skills
- Understand and comprehend a range of simple fractions
- Estimate and measure lengths using standard and non-standard measures
- Understand common mathematical vocabulary such as symmetrical and place value
- Begin to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes

Design & Technology

- Making and tasting food from different countries.
- Designing their own packaging for their own food from around the world.

Geography

- Looking at Geography around the world (temperature, landmarks, features, tourism)
- Visit to Estate agents
- Seas in the UK and World

Science

- Uses of everyday materials
- Electricity - being safe
- Seasons - Winter and Spring.

History

Changes within living and beyond living memory.

- Looking at big events that have changed how we live.
- Changes to communication, transport, toys, music,...
- Linking to our parents and grandparents childhoods. Important people from the past.

Modern Languages
