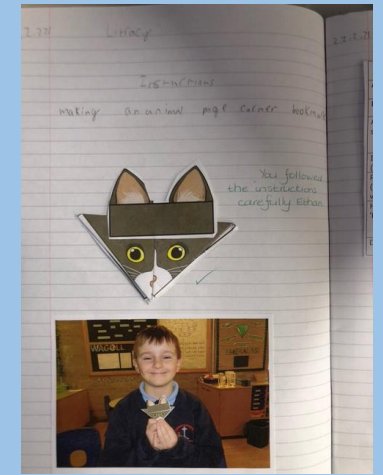
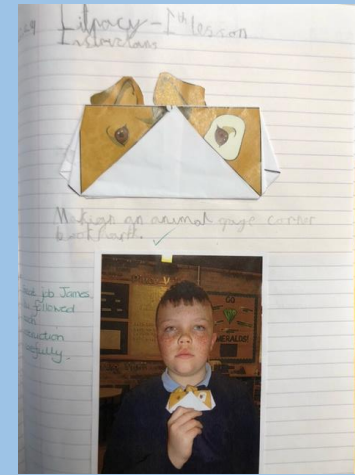
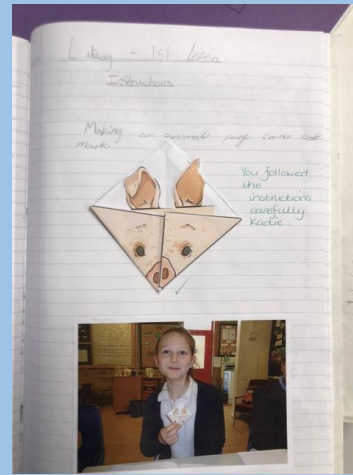
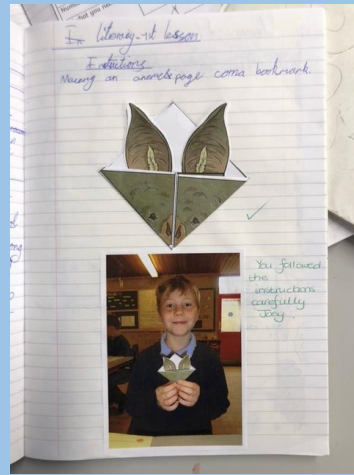
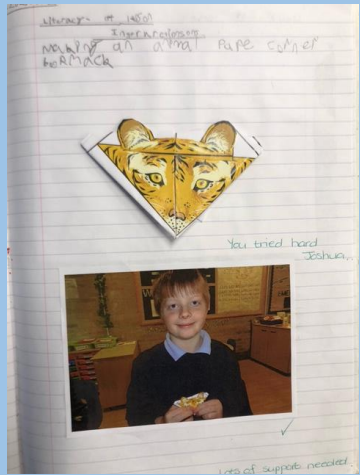
# Literacy

We had some lovely sandwiches made by our class at home this week following instructions, here they are!



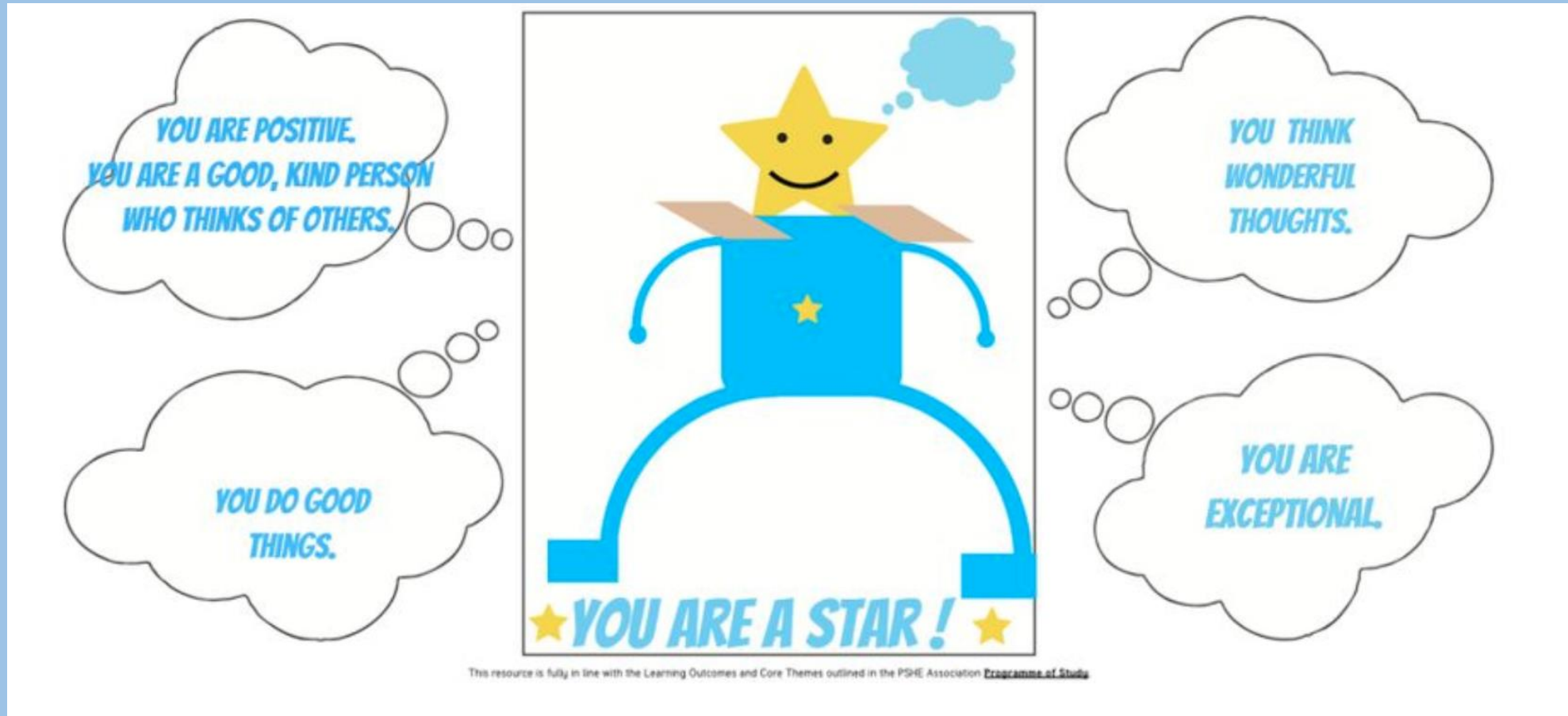

The children in class made some origami book marks using instructions.



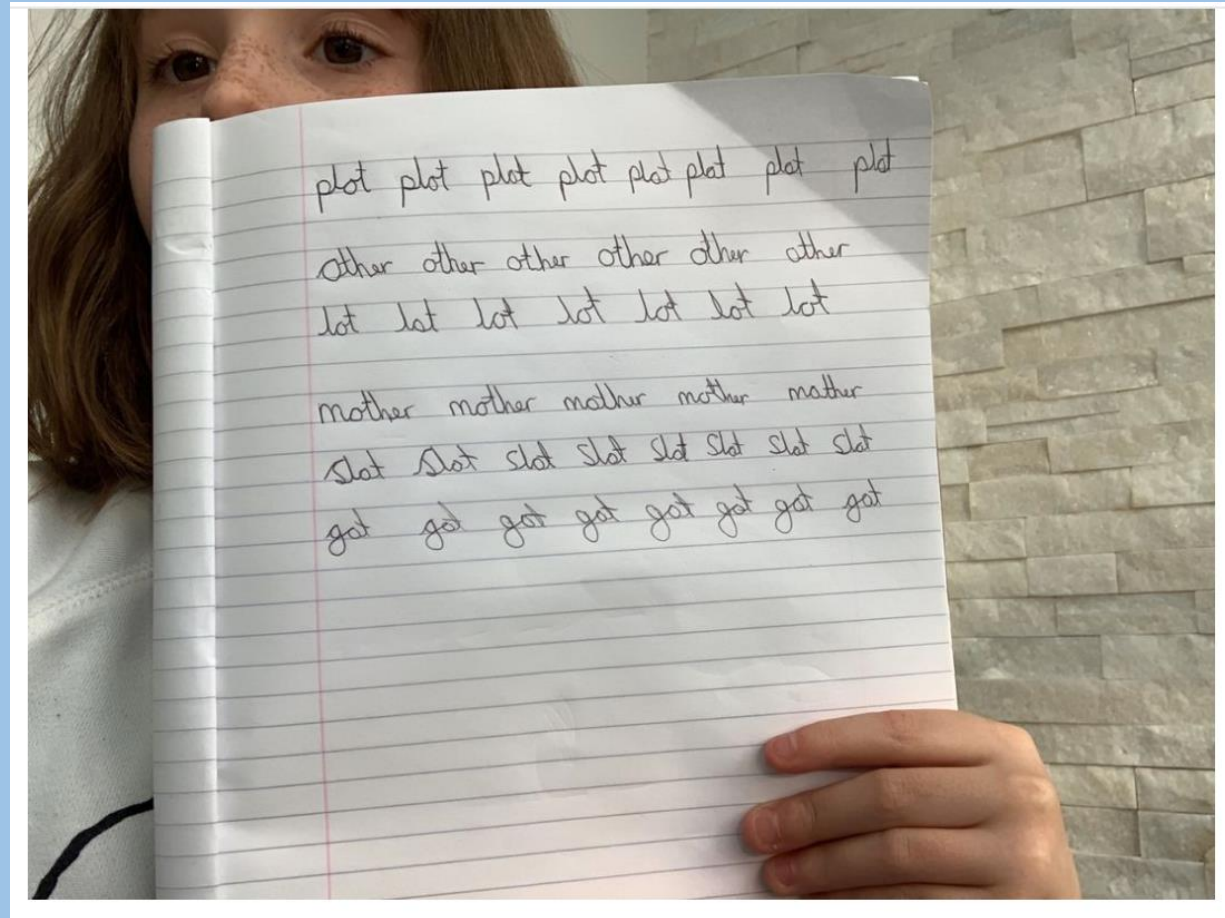
# Character Development

# Maths

We've been doing some great work over the last two weeks all around using Bar models. Ryan showed great understanding of how to use different representations to work out the answer to multiplication and division questions.

The image displays ten different mathematical representations, each illustrating a multiplication or division problem. Each representation is accompanied by a blue checkmark, indicating a correct solution.

- Bar model:  $9 = 36 \div 4$
- Bead string:  $9 = 27 \div 3$
- Dot pattern:  $27 = 9 \times 3$
- Bead string:  $32 = 4 \times 8$
- Bar model:  $24 = 3 \times 8$
- Bar model:  $24 \div 3 = 8$
- Dot pattern:  $28 \div 4 = 7$
- Dot pattern:  $4 \times 5 = 20$
- Dice:  $8 \times 4 = 32$
- Bar model:  $6 \times 3 = 18$
