

Spring term Plan – Ruby Learning Zone

English

- Looking at the language of persuasive writing and using it to write adverts and persuasive letters.
- Writing as different characters, maintaining the correct person and tense.
- Identify types of poetic language, such as alliteration, rhyme, similes and metaphors.
- Look at the poetry style of kennings in a link with our History topic of Anglo-Saxons.
- We will read 'Sam Wu is Not Afraid of the Dark' by Kevin and Katie Tsang for our class guided reading.

Art & Design

Our art topic this term focuses on architecture and specifically the works of Lord Norman Foster. We will be researching how his work is required to have durability, utility and beauty and try to incorporate that into our own designs.

Computing

We will be focusing on aspects of online safety this term, looking at how people can have different identities online and offline.

In the second part of the term Ruby will be looking at how photo editing is used.
