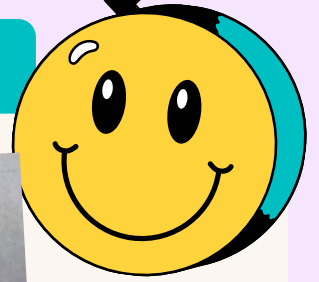
Hello I'm Ella and I do designing and I.T.
